The Palmyra City Council held a special council meeting in city hall on the above date with Mayor Loren Graham presiding and calling the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. The following council members answered roll call: Ken Sheputis, Jeff Merkel, Nathan Miller, Andrew Salsman, Josh Smith and Pam Behring. Also present was Brock Fahy and Trevor McDonald.

Council members discussed the two sales tax issues on the April ballot and how to get the message to the public. Mayor Graham will be submitting a letter to the editor explaining the ballot language and if the sale tax issues pass what the city plans to accomplish. Public meetings will also be held on February 27th and March 27th to answer questions from the citizens.

A motion was made by Council Member Sheputis and seconded by Council Member Salsman to enter into closed session for real estate.
