The Palmyra City Council met on the above date in city hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Loren Graham presiding and opening the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following council members answered roll call: Robert Lovegreen, Josh Smith, Pam Behring, Ken Sheputis and Nathan Miller. Council Member Jeff Merkel was absent. Mayor Graham thanked the Finance Committee and the department heads for their work during the budget process.
