The Palmyra City Council met on the above date in city hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Loren Graham presiding and opening the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following council members answered roll call: Pam Behring, Ken Sheputis, Jeff Merkel, Nathan Miller, Andrew Salsman and Josh Smith. Also present were Lynn Smith, Eddie Bogue, Mark Cheffey, Trevor McDonald, Ed Husar and Chase Hickman.

A motion was made by Council Member Miller and seconded by Council Member Behring to approve the consent agenda as presented. The roll call vote was as follows: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of the following:
