

CITY COUNCIL
PALMYRA, MISSOURI

July 20, 2017

The Palmyra City Council met on the above date in city hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Loren Graham presiding and opening the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following council members answered roll call: Pam Behring, Ken Sheputis, Jeff Merkel, Nathan Miller, Andrew Salsman and Josh Smith. Also present was Lynn Smith, Eddie Bogue and Mark Cheffey.

A motion was made by Council Member Behring and seconded by Council Member Miller to approve the consent agenda as presented. The roll call vote was as following: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of the following:

- a. Approval of the July 6th minutes
- b. Approval of the July 13th special meeting minutes
- c. Bills for Approval
- d. Financial Report – June.

A special meeting of the council was scheduled for Thursday, August 31st at 6:00 p.m. to discuss the storm water plan.

City Clerk Parsons provided the second reading of Bill #1551 entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 210 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PALMYRA REGULATING THE GROWTH OF WEEDS, GRASS, OR POISONOUS OR HARMFUL VEGETATION, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.” A motion was made by Council Member Smith and seconded by Council Member Behring to pass and approve Bill #1551. The roll call vote was as following: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried. Bill #1551 became Ordinance #1188-17-01.

City Clerk Parsons provided the second reading of Bill #1552 entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 415.010 OF THE CITY CODE OF PALMYRA, MISSOURI, REGULATING KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.” A motion was made by Council Member Salsman and seconded by Council Member Behring to pass and approve Bill #1552. The roll call vote was as following: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried. Bill #1552 became Ordinance #1189-17-02.

City Clerk Parsons provided the second reading of Bill #1553 entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 412.100 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PALMYRA REGULATING CONDOMINIUMS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.” A motion was made by Council Member Sheputis and seconded by Council Member Merkel to pass and approve Bill #1553. The roll call vote was as following: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried. Bill #1553 became Ordinance #1190-17-03.

A motion was made by Council Member Sheputis and seconded by Council Member Merkel to authorize Mayor Graham and the city clerk to execute the Contract and Notice to Proceed with D&L Excavating Inc. for repairs to the culvert on North Main. The roll call vote was as following: Ayes: Behring, Sheputis, Merkel, Miller, Salsman and Smith. Nays: None. The motion carried.

Council Member Behring mentioned the grounds looking bad at the multifamily dwellings on Industrial Drive. Behring also stated she was happy to see the Tastee Freeze back open and busy.

Mayor Graham mentioned the contract training scheduled for July 25th has been postponed and will be rescheduled.

With no further business before the council a motion to adjourn was made at 7:32 p.m.
